
SUBJECT: **CLOSURE OF THE UNIVERSITY**

This is to notify all students that following the Presidential Directive on suspension of learning in Education Institutions due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic, the University Senate met today and resolved to close the University until further notice with effect from **tomorrow, Tuesday, 17th March, 2020**. All students are requested to clear and vacate from their respective Campus premises by 4.00 p.m. Further to this:

- 1) All resident students will be expected to remove their personal belongings from their rooms and hand over the keys to the Director, Accommodation Services.
- 2) International students who either wish to travel back to their respective home countries or those who wish to stay on campus are expected to register with Director, International Programmes and Collaborations.

Besides the closure of the University, all students are urged to strictly adhere to the safety and health measures announced by the Ministry of Health and which are also posted on the University's website so as to avoid being exposed to the deadly Coronavirus.
