Today we shall look at the University's commitment to develop an inclusive learning environment for Students with Disability.

The University is committed to developing an inclusive learning environment for students with disabilities. The University shall require students to disclose any disabilities or disability related conditions to ensure that appropriate support is arranged for them in a timely fashion. The University shall offer the following services:

Pre-entry Advice

Prospective students with disabilities will be supplied with information about support services available for their needs while on campus.

Physical Access on Campus

Students and staff with mobility difficulties will be supported in moving between locations on campus.

Assistive Technology

Students with disabilities shall have access to specialized learning equipment and shall continually be advised on emergent assistive technology devices.

Advice on Financial Assistance

STUWD often incur additional study-related costs as a consequence of their disability. Further information on assistance in applying and advice on eligibility shall be given to them on application.

Examination Support

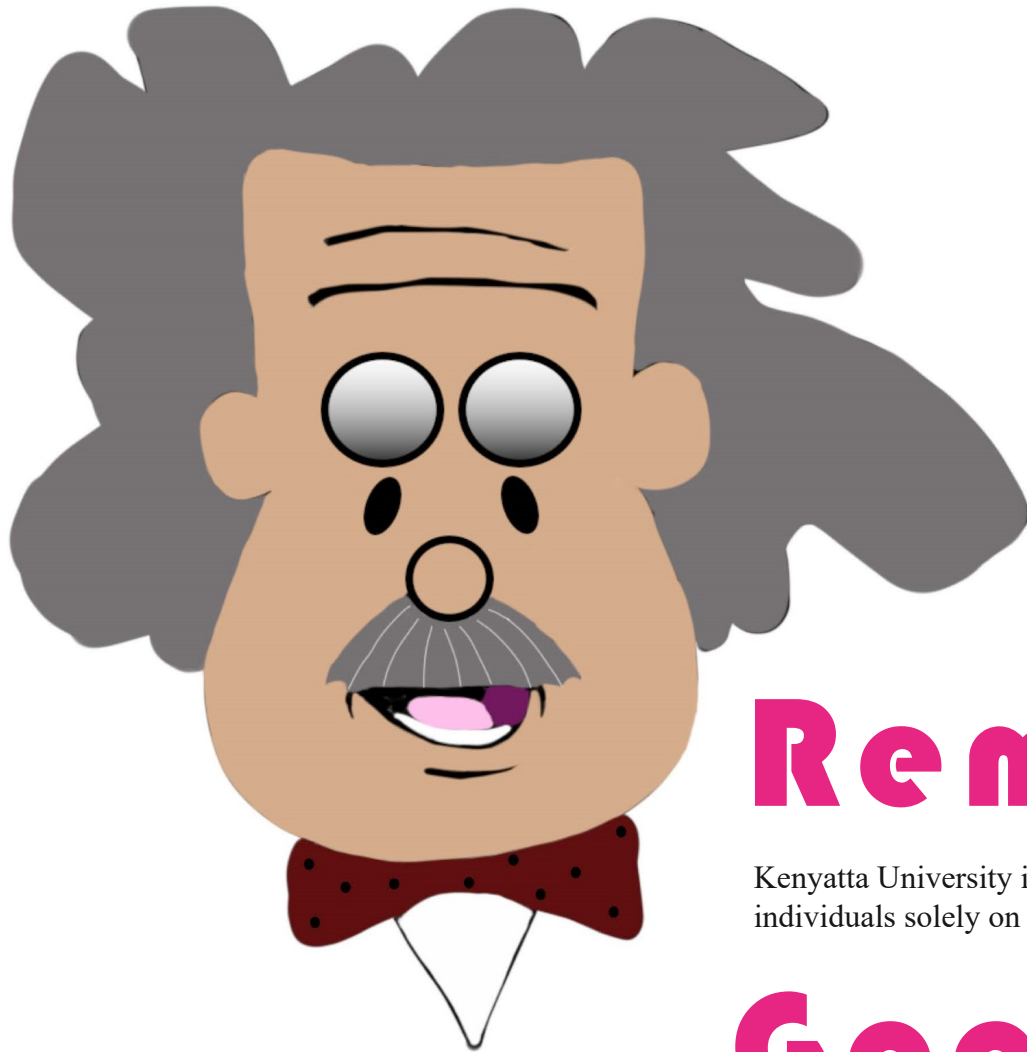
Directorate of Disability Services (DODS) shall be responsible for assessing the needs of students in need of special examination arrangements and for informing Schools about such requirements. All examination arrangements have to be supported by relevant evidence of need and it is the responsibility of the student to provide it.

Referral to Support Agencies

Where appropriate DODS will refer students to internal departments such as Peer counseling services (PCS), Directorate of Wellness and Rehabilitation Services (DWRS) and Directorate of Students Affairs (DSA). External support agencies shall be contacted as need arise.

Reasonable Adjustment and Universal Design

The University will undertake reasonable adjustments/actions that help to alleviate a substantial disadvantage. Universal Design will be utilized wherever possible.
