

INVENTION EDUCATION (IVE) SEED GRANT CALL

The **Rice360 Institute for Global Health Technologies** together with **Kenyatta University** are working to develop a scalable model for invention education (IvE) that empowers innovators to address pressing local and global challenges.

One of the planned activities in the first quarter of 2023 is to implement a **faculty research catalyst award of \$ 7,500** at Kenyatta University. This will support successful individual faculty and teams of faculty proposals that cut across multiple schools and departments **with a seed grant of KES. 50,000 to KES. 200,000.**

We plan to establish rolling application and review mechanisms at KU as well as structured mechanisms of support for faculty who receive the seed grants, including monitoring and evaluation of activities.
