SCHOOL OF EDUCATION
<u>DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES:</u> Diploma in Primary Teacher Education. Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru, Embu and Kitui Minimum requirements: i. Mean grade of C + (Plus) in KCSE and C + (Plus) in any two subjects of specialization with C Plain in English and Mathematics for Science based courses D + (Plus) in Mathematics in non-science based courses. ii. Minimum grade C (Plain) and above in KCSE with a Certificate in Education from KNEC Course Duration: 2 (Two) years
Diploma in Educational Leadership and Management. Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or its equivalent. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years
Diploma in Guidance and Counselling Campuses: Main and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KACE. OR mean grade C - (Minus) at KCSE or its equivalent with Certificate in relevant area. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years
<u>UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES:</u> Bachelor of Education (Arts) Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Embu, Kitui and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in two subjects of career choice Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education (Science) Campus: Main, Mombasa, Embu, Kitui and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in two subjects of choice and C (Plain) in Mathematics. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood Education) Campus: Main Minimum requirements

i. C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent. ii. C (Plain) with a Diploma in Early Childhood Education from a recognized institution. iii. C - (Minus) in KCSE with a Certificate and Diploma in ECE from a recognized institution. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education (Special Needs Education) Campus: Main i. Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C+ (Plus) in one of the following subjects: English/Kiswahili, Mathematics/Biology or any Arts subject. ii. Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or its equivalent with one (1) Principal and one (1) Subsidiary and be a holder of P1, S1 certificate or Diploma in Special Needs Education from a recognized institution with at least (2) years teaching experience after training. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education (Physical Education) Campus: Main Minimum requirements i. Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in two teaching subjects at KCSE. ii. Mean grade of C (Plain) with a Diploma in Education or related field of study from a recognized institution. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education in Primary Teacher Education Campuses: Main Minimum requirements i. Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C+ (Plus) or equivalent in two subjects of career choice or two (2) Principles and one (1) Subsidiary pass at 'A' level. ii. Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or its equivalent with at least C (Plain) or its equivalent in two subjects of career choice and have undertaken a Diploma in Education or gone through A level system in relevant area(s) in accredited institution. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
Bachelor of Education in Library Science Campus: Main Campus Minimum requirements i. Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent. ii. Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma in Library Science and/or Information Science or Archives Administration. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years
SCHOOL OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
Bachelor of Arts Campus: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru and Embu Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in three subjects chosen from English, Kiswahili, History and Government, Geography, Mathematics, Christian Religious Education, Business Studies, Islamic Religious Education, French, German, Hindu Religious Education. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years

SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND APPLIED HUMAN SCIENCES.

Bachelor of Science (Environmental Health)

Campus: Main

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C+ (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in the following subjects: Mathematics/Physics, Chemistry/Physical Sciences, Biology/Biological Sciences, English / Kiswahili **OR** A Diploma with at least a credit from a recognized institution in the following areas: Environmental Health, Environmental Studies, Water and Civil engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing, Clinical medicine, Biomedical Laboratory technology, Biomedical sciences, Public Health ,Community Health and Nursing, Nutrition or any other health related courses. In addition the candidate should have obtained a C (Plain) at KCSE. Those who had a C - (Minus) at KCSE progressed from certificate to any of the above Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years

Bachelor of Science (Health Records and Information Management)

Campus: Main

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in English/Kiswahili, C (Plain) in Biology/Biological Sciences and C (Plain) Mathematics **OR** Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or equivalent with Diploma of at least Credit Pass in Health Records and Information Technology from a recognized institution. Those with Diploma must have at least 2 years relevant post qualification experience **OR** Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma (same course) at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions and two years' experience.
