INSTITUTION BASED PROGRAMMES OFFERED IN MAIN CAMPUS AND SATELLITE CAMPUSES DECEMBER, 2017 INTAKE

Applications are invited from qualified applicants for the following programmes which will be offered in the Academic year **2017/2018** beginning in **December, 2017** at **Main, Nakuru, Nyeri, Mombasa, Kitui, Kericho and Embu Campuses**.

The programmes are offered during the school holidays i.e. the months of **April, August and December**.

Minimum Entry Requirements for Certificate, Diploma and Bachelors Degree programmes

1. Certificate Programmes	- Minimum Mean Grade C- (Minus) in KCSE or its equivalent.
2. Diploma Programmes	- Minimum Mean Grade C (Plain) in KCSE or its equivalent.
3. Bachelors Degree Programmes	- Minimum Mean Grade C+ (Plus) in KCSE or its equivalent.

Minimum Entry Requirements for Postgraduate Programmes

1. Postgraduate Diploma Programmes - Bachelor's Degree in a related field with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenya University or any recognized Institution OR Bachelor's Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) or its equivalent with at least two years of relevant work experience.
2. Master Programmes - Bachelor's Degree in a related field with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenya University or any recognized Institution OR Bachelor's Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) or its equivalent with at least two years of relevant work experience.
3. Doctor of Philosophy Programmes - Master's degree in relevant area of study from Kenya University or any other recognized institution.

MODE OF APPLICATION

- Application forms can either be obtained from Kenya University Main Campus, Admissions Block, Room No. 012 and from the other campuses/ Regional Centres located in **Nairobi City, Mombasa, Nakuru, Kitui, Nyeri, Embu, Kericho, Garissa, Kisumu, Kakamega and Marsabit** or be downloaded from Kenya University website at www.ku.ac.ke on payment of a non-refundable fee of **Kshs. 2,000/-** for East Africans and **Kshs. 4,000/-** for applicants from outside East Africa.
- Duly completed forms should be returned to the Registrar (Academic), Admissions Block Room 012, Kenya University on or before **24th November, 2017**. Copies of relevant certificates, Academic transcripts and original application fee receipt **MUST** be attached to the Application form.

NB: O'Level Certificate must be attached: For those applying for Bachelors Degree with Grade C (Plain) at K.C.S.E, they must have a Diploma and those with C- (Minus) must have a Certificate and progression to a Diploma in relevant areas of study.
