PRE-GRADUATION INFORMATION PAMPHLET

To all our esteemed Graduands for the 50th Graduation Ceremony, kindly take note of the following important information:

1. You are expected to collect your academic attire from your respective School from Monday 6th to Wednesday 16th December, 2021. You will be required to strictly adhere to the Ministry of Health COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS when collecting the attire.
2. REHEARSALS will be held on Wednesday 15th December, 2021 starting at 9:00 am. It will be streamed live through a link to be sent through your students' corporate email.
3. A different log-in link will be sent to your students' corporate email to enable you join the virtual ceremony on the GRADUATION DAY (17th December, 2021). The link will be activated at 7:00 a.m.
4. You will therefore be expected to log into the virtual ceremony at 7:00 a.m. on the 17th December, 2021.
5. The CEREMONY WILL OFFICIALLY START at 8:30 a.m. and will be streamed live on KUTV, KTN NEWS, KU Website, Lola App and all social media platforms (i.e. Facebook, Twitter and YouTube).

7. **DECORUM AND DECENCY** during the graduation ceremony:
 - You are required to **MAINTAIN HIGH DISCIPLINE AND DECORUM** during this auspicious occasion.
 - You are required to take a **CLEAR PASSPORT SIZE PHOTO**, preferably **IN ACADEMIC ATTIRE**, to be used as your graduation account profile picture.
 - A **KU-branded background** will also be sent to your corporate email for you to download and use on your virtual account.
 - You are required to remain logged-in, on camera and seated unless called upon to arise during conferment of various degrees or award of diplomas and certificates.
 - Even after conferment of various degrees or award of diplomas and certificates, **YOU ARE EXPECTED TO REMAIN LOGGED-IN, ON CAMERA AND SEATED** and to **MAINTAIN DECENCY AND ORDER** until the congregation is dissolved.
8. **ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES/TRANSCRIPTS**
 - Certificates and transcripts will be issued as per the schedule to be advertised in the daily newspapers, KU Website and social media platforms.
 - You will also be issued with a **GRADUATION BOOKLET** after collecting your Certificate.
