SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF PHYSICAL LEARNING

On Friday, 26th March, 2021, the President issued the Public Order No.2 of 2021 on COVID-19. The order in paragraph 13, Section XIII directed for immediate suspension of all on-going physical learning in all educational institutions including universities other than for students in medical training institutions.

In view of this directive, the University Senate met on Monday, 29th March, 2021 and resolved as follows:

- 1) That 2nd and 3rd year students should **clear and vacate from Campuses**.
- 2) That students in the schools of Pharmacy, Medicine and Nursing should remain on Campus for face-to-face teaching and learning, practicals and examinations.
- 3) That all the examinations that were scheduled for **29th March to 9th April 2021** should continue.
- 4) All examinations for all other groups be postponed until further notice.
- 5) International students who wish to stay on campus are expected to register with the Director, International Programmes and Collaborations and the Director, Accommodation Services.

Further to this:

- 1) All other students are requested to clear and vacate from their respective Campuses by **Thursday, 1st April 2021 by 4.00 p.m.**
- 2) The University will provide travel passes to students who wish to move out of the restricted counties.

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- 3) To enable the students to settle down, all online teaching and learning will resume/commence on **Tuesday, 6th April 2021**.
- 4) In the meantime, the University will watch how events unfold and review and advice accordingly.

We urge all students to continue adhering to the safety and health measures announced by the Ministry of Health so as to avoid being exposed to the COVID-19.
