RE: TEACHING AND LEARNING AMIDST THE SUSPENSION OF PHYSICAL LEARNING

The above subject refers.

On Monday 29th March, 2021, the University Senate suspended physical learning as per the Presidential Public order No. 2 of 2021 on COVID-19.

Further to the memo dated 29th March, 2021, we would like to clarify on the following;

- 1) That **ALL** physical teaching and learning was suspended except for students in the Schools of Medicine, Pharmacy and Nursing.
- 2) Those students who started exams on Monday 29th March, 2021, will undertake the exams to completion.
- 3) That learning and examination should continue at the Kenya Military Academy.
- 4) That **ALL** other exams except as defined in (1), (2) and (3) have been suspended, until further notice.
- 5) That teaching and learning will continue as per the attached schedule.

We urge all students to continue adhering to the Safety and Health measures announced by the Government so as to avoid being exposed to the Coronavirus.
