Minimum Entry Requirements

1. Certificate Programmes	- Minimum Mean grade C- (Minus) at KCSE or its equivalent.
2. Diploma Programmes	- Minimum Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or its equivalent.
3. Diploma in Information Technology (DIT) - City Campus Part time & Full - Time	- Minimum Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE OR equivalent with C (Plain) in both Mathematics and English.
4. Bachelors Degree Programmes	- Minimum Mean grade C+ (Plus) at KCSE or its equivalent.
5. Bachelor of Information Technology (BIT) - City Campus Part time & Full - Time	- Minimum Mean grade C + (Plus) at KCSE OR equivalent with C + (Plus) in both Mathematics and English. OR Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE with a C (plain) in both Mathematics and English or Equivalent and a Diploma in Information Technology or relevant field of study with a credit pass from a recognized institution.
6. Postgraduate Diploma Programmes	- Bachelor's Degree in a related field with at least Second Class Honors (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized Institution OR Bachelor's Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) or its equivalent with at least two years of relevant work experience.
7. Masters Programmes	- Bachelor's Degree in a related field with at least Second Class Honors (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized Institution OR Bachelor's Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) or its equivalent with at least two years of relevant work experience.
8. Doctor of Philosophy Programmes	- Master's degree in relevant area of study from Kenyatta University or any other recognized institution.

i. **GUIDELINE FOR ONLINE APPLICATION.**

 - Academic Transcripts and Certificates.
 - Passport photo.
 - Identification documents, either a National Identity Card or Passport.

Application forms can be obtained from Kenyatta University, Admissions Block, Office No. 12 or at the Regional Centers based in **Nairobi, Embu, Mombasa, Nakuru, Kericho, Kisumu and Garissa** or be downloaded from our website.
