Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.

<u>DEGREE PROGRAMMES:</u> a) Bachelor of Arts: Campus: Main, Nakuru, Mombasa and Embu Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in three subjects chosen from English, Kiswahili, Literature, History and Government, Geography, Mathematics, Christian Religious Education, Islamic Religious Education. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
b) Bachelor of Arts (Christian Studies) Campuses: Main, Mombasa and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in Christian Religious Education, Islamic Religious Education or Social Education and Ethics at Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
c) Bachelor of Arts (African Religion And Culture) Campuses: Main, Mombasa and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in Christian Religious Education, Islamic

Religious Education or Social Education and Ethics at Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

d) Bachelor of Arts (Islamic Studies)

Campuses: Main, Mombasa and Nakuru

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in Islamic Religious Education or Social Education and Ethics at Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

3. SCHOOL OF NURSING

Bachelor of Science (Nursing and Public Health)

Main Campus Only

Minimum requirements

Applicants must be;

(a) Kenya Registered Community Health Nurse (KRCHN)/Registered Nurse Midwife (KRN/M) from a recognized nurse training institution.

(b) Registered/ licensed as a Nurse by Nursing Council of Kenya.

(c) Have a Mean grade of at least **C (Plain)** at KCSE/Division II at KCE **and** with at least two (2) years working experience post registration experience.

Course Duration: 2½(Two and a half) years.

4. SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE & ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT.

DEGREE PROGRAMMES:

a) Bachelor of Science (Agriculture)

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent and a minimum of C + (Plus) in any three (3) of the following subjects Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture or Geography, Mathematics or Physics/Physical Sciences

OR Mean Grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or its equivalent with a Diploma of at least a Credit pass in a subject related to Agriculture, Environmental studies, Applied Biology or any other related discipline from a recognized institution. **OR** At least two (2) Principals and one (1) Subsidiary in science subjects with a Principal pass in Biology at KACE (A level) or its equivalent.

Students can also transfer from other Institutions or Departments to the University on Credit transfer provided they meet the minimum admission requirements.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

b) Bachelor of Science (Crop Improvement and Protection)

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

A mean grade C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent and a minimum of C + (Plus) or equivalent in Biology/Biological Sciences and any two (2) of the following subjects: Chemistry, Geography, Agriculture, Physical Science/Physics. In addition, applicants must have obtained grade C (Plain) in Mathematics at KCSE or equivalent. **OR** Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE with a Diploma of at least credit pass in a relevant field of study from a recognized institution. **OR** at least two (2) Principals and one (1) Subsidiary in science

subjects with a principal pass in Biology at KACE (A-level) or its equivalent.

Students can also transfer from other Institutions or Departments to the University on Credit transfer provided they meet the minimum admission requirements.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

c) Bachelor of Science (Agribusiness Management)

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

A mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent and a minimum of C + in Mathematics and in two of the following combinations: Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture or Geography and Economics or Business Studies and Physical Science. **OR** Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent and two-year (minimum) Diploma with a Credit in Agriculture, Commerce, Accounting, Economics, Farm management, Agribusiness or any other related discipline from an institution recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

d) Bachelor of Science in Dry Land Agriculture and Enterprise Development

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

A mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent, and a minimum of C + (Plus) in any three of the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture or Geography, Mathematics or Physics or Physical sciences. **OR** Mean grade C (Plain) in KCSE or its equivalent and a Diploma with minimum credit in a subject related to Agriculture Environmental Studies, Applied Biology or any other related discipline from a recognized institution. **OR** Mean grade of C - (Minus) at KCSE and Progressed from certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited Institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

e) Bachelor of Science (Agricultural Resource Management)

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

A mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent, and a minimum of C + (Plus) in any three of the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture or Geography, Mathematics or Physics or Physical sciences. Applicants with 'A' level certificate with at least one principal in requisite subjects the above criteria or applicants with International Baccalaureate certification. **OR** Grade C (Plain) in KCSE or its equivalent and a Diploma with a minimum of credit in a subject related to Agriculture, Environmental Studies, Applied Biology, Agribusiness or any other related discipline from a recognized Institution. **OR** mean grade of C - (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

f) Bachelor of Science (Animal Health and Production)

Campus: Kitui

Minimum requirements

A mean grade C + (Plus) at KCSE with at least C + (Plus) in Biology or Biological Sciences and any one of the following subjects: Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Physical Sciences **OR** Two Principals and one Subsidiary pass at KACE level or equivalent, one of which must be in Biology and in any science subject. **OR** a minimum of C (Plain) in KCSE and at least Credit in Diploma in Animal Health/Agricultural/Medical

Laboratory Technology/Animal Production/Range Management from an institution recognised by University Senate. **OR** a minimum of C - (Minus) at KCSE with at least a Credit pass in Certificate and Diploma in Animal Health/Agriculture/ Medical Laboratory Technology/Animal Production/Range management from an institution recognized by the University Senate. **OR** A degree in a Biological Science or any other qualification to the above from institutions recognised by the University Senate. **OR** mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited Institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

g) Bachelor of Science (Agricultural Education and Extension)

Campus: Kitui Only

Minimum requirements

A mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent and a minimum of C + (Plus) in the following subjects: Biology, Agriculture or Geography, Chemistry, Mathematics/Physics/Physical Sciences. **OR** Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent and a Diploma with a minimum Credit in Agricultural Education or related Agricultural Course, Environmental Science, Applied Biology, Agribusiness or any other related discipline from a recognized institution. **OR** mean grade of C - (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent.

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE **OR** Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE with a P1 certificate or Early Childhood Certificate from a recognized institution.

b) Diploma in Primary Teacher Education.

Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru and Embu

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE.

Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.

c) Diploma in Educational Leadership and Management.

Campus: Main

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or its equivalent **OR** P1 or its equivalent with at least two years' work experience.

Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.
d) Diploma in Information Science (DIS) Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE OR Holders of KNEC Certificate in Library and Information Studies or its equivalent with an overall pass of Credit or Distinction or pass with two or more year's relevant practical experience. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.
e) Diploma in Records Management and Information Technology (DRIT) Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE OR Holders of KNEC Certificate in Library and Information Science or its equivalent with an overall pass of Credit or Distinction or a pass with two or more year's relevant practical experience. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.
f) Diploma in Guidance and Counselling Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE. OR mean grade C - (Minus) at KCSE or equivalent with Certificate in relevant area. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.
g) Diploma in Clinical and Child Neuropsychology Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or at least one (1) Principal and one (1) Subsidiary in KACE. OR Mean grade of C - (Minus) at KCSE or equivalent with a P1 in Early Childhood or Special Needs Education Certificate and at least two years teaching experience. OR Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE or equivalent with a certificate in a Medical field and at least two years relevant experience. Applicants with at least grade C (Plain) or Credit 6 in English, Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics at KCSE and KCE respectively will have an added advantage. Course Duration: 2 (Two) years.

OR Mean grade of C - (Minus) at KCSE and progressed

from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
b) Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood Education) Campus: Main, Mombasa, Embu and Nakuru Minimum requirements Mean grade of C+ (plus). OR Mean grade of C (plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a P1 certificate. OR a Diploma in Early Childhood Education from a recognized institution. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
c) Bachelor of Education (Science) Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru and Embu Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in two subjects of choice and C (Plain) or equivalent in Mathematics. OR Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or equivalent with P1 Certificate or Diploma in Science Education or KACE with two (2) Principals and one (1) Subsidiary with at least two (2) years teaching experience. In addition, applicants must have obtained Grade C (Plain) or equivalent in Mathematics at KCSE. OR Mean Grade C - (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
d) Bachelor of Education (Home Economics) Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent and at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in Home Science and Chemistry or Physics or Geography or English or Mathematics or any subjects taught in High Schools. OR Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
e) Bachelor of Education (Physical Education) Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent OR Mean grade C (Plain) with a Diploma in Education or related field of study from a recognized institution. OR Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
f) Bachelor of Education (Primary Teacher Education) Campuses: Main and Embu Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) or equivalent in two (2) Subjects of career choice OR Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or equivalent or one (1) Principal and one (1) Subsidiary at KACE and be holders of P1, S1, or Diploma in Education from a recognized Institution with at least two (2) years teaching experience after training. OR Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions. Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.
g) Bachelor of Education (Library Science) Campus: Main Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent OR Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma in Library Science and/or Information Science or Archives Administration. **OR** Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

h) Bachelor of Library and Information Science

Campus: Main

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent. **OR** Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma in Library Science and/or Information Science or Archives Administration. **OR** Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

i) Bachelor of Science (Records Management and Information Technology)

Campus: Main

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent **OR** Mean C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma in Library Science or Records Science or Archives Management. **OR** Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years.

j) Bachelor of Education (Special Needs Education)

Campuses: Main, Nakuru and Embu

Specialization areas: i) Physical Disabilities ii) Learning Disabilities iii) Emotional and Behavioral Disorders iv) Intellectual Challenges.

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C+ (plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C+ (plus) in any one of the following subjects: English/Kiswahili, Mathematics/Biology and any Arts subjects **OR** Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or equivalent or one (1) Principal and one (1) Subsidiary at KACE and be holders of P1, S1, or Diploma in Special Education from a recognized Institution with at least two (2) years teaching experience after training. **OR** Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate a Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4 (Four) years

6. SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND APPLIED HUMAN SCIENCES.

a) Bachelor of Science (Environmental Health)

Minimum requirements

Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in the following subjects: Mathematics/Physics, Chemistry/Physical Sciences, Biology/Biological Sciences, English / Kiswahili **OR** A Diploma with at least a Credit from a recognized institution in the following areas: Environmental Health, Environmental Studies, Water and Civil engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing, Clinical Medicine, Biomedical Laboratory Technology, Biomedical Sciences, Public Health, Community Health and Nursing, Nutrition or any other health related courses. In addition the candidate should have obtained a C (Plain) at KCSE. Those who had a C - (Minus) at KCSE progressed from Certificate to any of the above Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions.

Course Duration: 4years
b) Bachelor of Science (Health Records and Information Management) Campus: Main Minimum requirements Mean grade of C + (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C + (Plus) in English/Kiswahili, Biology/Biological Sciences and Mathematics OR Mean grade C (Plain) at KCSE or Division III at KCE or equivalent with Diploma of at least Credit pass in Health Records and Information Technology from a recognized institution. Those with Diploma must have at least 2 years relevant post qualification experience. OR Mean grade of C – (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma at Kenyatta University or any other recognized/accredited institutions Course Duration: 4years
7. SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY TOURISM AND LEISURE STUDIES
DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES: a) Hospitality Management Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru, Embu and Kitui Minimum requirements Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent. In addition, candidates must have obtained grade C- (Minus) in two subjects chosen from the following categories: Alternative A : English/Kiswahili, Chemistry, Biology Alternative B: English/Kiswahili, Biological Sciences/Physical Sciences/Chemistry, Home Science OR Mean grade C - (Minus) at KCSE with a certificate in a field related to Hospitality from a recognized institution and two (2) years of relevant experience. Course Duration: 2 years
b) Diploma in Tourism Management Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru, Kitui and Embu Minimum requirements Mean Grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent. Candidates must have done any two the following subjects at KCSE and passed with a minimum grade of C in each: Biology/Biological Sciences, Geography/History, Business Education/Computers, English/Foreign Language. OR Mean grade C - (Minus) at KCSE with a Certificate in a field related to Tourism from a recognized institution and two (2) years of relevant experience. Course Duration: 2 years
DEGREE PROGRAMMES: Bachelor of Science (Hospitality and Tourism Management) Campuses: Main, Mombasa, Nakuru, Kitui and Embu Minimum requirements Mean grade of C+ (Plus) at KCSE. Candidates must have done any three (3) of the following subjects at KCSE and passed with a minimum grade of C+ (Plus) English/Kiswahili/Foreign Languages; Biology/Biological Sciences; Chemistry/Physical Sciences/Physics/Mathematics; Home Science; Geography/History; Business Studies/Commerce/Economics/Agriculture. OR Mean grade of C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma with a minimum of Credit pass in a related area from a recognized institution. OR Mean grade of C- (Minus) at KCSE and progressed from Certificate to Diploma in a related area from a recognized institution. Course Duration: 4 years
