The entry requirements for each Programme are as shown below:

SCHOOL OF EDUCATION
Department of Education Communication Technology Post-graduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized institution. Applicants should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree with two (2) teaching subjects.
Department of Early Childhood & Special Needs Education Master of Education in Early Childhood Studies Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Education Degree in Early Childhood Studies, with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any recognized institution. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Library and Information Science Master of Library and Information Science Minimum Entry Requirements A holder of a Bachelor Degree or its equivalent in any branch of Knowledge who has attained at least an Upper Second Class Honours or its equivalent. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have at least one (1) year work experience.
Department of Library and Information Science Master of Science Records Management and Archives Administration Minimum Entry Requirements A holder of a Bachelor's degree of at least Upper Second Class or its equivalent in any discipline shall be eligible for registration for the Master of Information Science. Holders of a Bachelor's degree of at least Lower Second Class or its equivalent in any discipline with relevant work experience of at least two (2) years shall be eligible for registration.
Department of Library and Information Science Master of Science Knowledge Management Minimum Entry Requirements Holders of a Bachelor's degree with Second Class Honours (Upper Division) of Kenyatta University or equivalent from a recognized university. Holders of a Lower Second Class Honours degree from a recognized university with at least two (2) years relevant work experience or Holders of a Lower Second Class Honours degree from a

recognized university with relevant Postgraduate professional qualifications.
SCHOOL OF BUSINESS
Department of Business Administration Master of Business Administration (MBA) with areas of Specialization in: (a) Human Resource Management (b) Entrepreneurship (c) Marketing (d) Finance (e) Procurement and Supply Chain Management (f) Strategic Management (g) Management Information Systems (h) Project Management (i) Accounting Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university. Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university with proven ability in research, administration or management. A holder of a degree from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university plus relevant full professional qualification certificate.
SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT
Department of Hospitality and Tourism Management Master of Science in Hospitality Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) and above in Hospitality and Tourism Management and related fields Those with Second Class (Lower Division) in Hospitality and Tourism Management and related area with at least two years relevant work experience.
Department of Hospitality and Tourism Management Master of Science in Tourism Management Minimum Entry Requirements A holder of Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management (Second Class Honours Upper Division and above) and/or related field. A holder of Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management (Second Class Lower Division) and related field with at least 2 years relevant work experience.
SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE AND ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Integrated Soil Fertility Management (ISFM) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree in Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dry land Agriculture & Enterprise Development, Agricultural Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension, Plant and Microbial Sciences, Geography or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Dryland Agriculture Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dryland Agriculture, Animal Production and Health Management, Agricultural

Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension, Agricultural Economics or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Land and Water Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dryland Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Plant Breeding Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology M.Sc. Crop Protection in a) Entomology Option b) Pathology Option Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Seed Technology and Trade Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science Degree with at least First Class or Second Class Honours (Upper Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate. Holders of Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have grade ‘C’ and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization or a postgraduate diploma.
Department of Animal Sciences Master of Science in Animal Nutrition and Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree in Animal Production and Health Management, Veterinary Medicine, Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dry land Agriculture, Range Management or any other equivalent qualification from Kenyatta University or other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate. Holders of B.Sc degree with lower second class honours in the agricultural related areas must have at least two years relevant experience.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science (Agronomy) Minimum Entry Requirements Holders of Bachelor’s degree with at least First Class or Upper Second Class Honours in Agriculture, or any other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institution a recognized by Kenyatta University Senate. Holders of Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have “C” and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization or a Postgraduate Diploma.
SCHOOL OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
Department of Geography Master of Science in Geomorphology

Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent in Engineering, Hydrology, and related disciplines, Natural Sciences or Social and Human Sciences from a recognized university. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Geography Master of Arts in Urban and Regional Planning Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Arts, Science or Bachelor of Education Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from a recognized university and has studied Geography either as a major or regular subject to a degree level. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Public Policy and Administration: Masters of Arts in Public Policy and Administration (MPPA) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree of at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) from a recognized university in any area of specialization. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Kiswahili Master of Arts in Kiswahili Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any recognized university with an average grade of 'B' in Kiswahili units. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) and at least two years relevant work experience may be considered.
SCHOOL OF SECURITY, DIPLOMACY AND PEACE STUDIES
Department of Conflict, Peace and Conflict Management Master of Arts in Peace and Conflict Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper or Lower Division) from Kenyatta University or any other recognized by the university senate. Those who are eligible to apply are fresh graduates in the disciplines of conflict and peace, political, development and gender studies, history, sociology, law, international relations, public policy and administration and personnel working with civil societies, government and the public sector interested in pursuing the discipline of peace and conflict.
