The entry requirements for each Programme are as shown below:

SCHOOL OF EDUCATION
Department of Education Communication Technology Post-graduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized institution. Applicants should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree with two (2) teaching subjects.
Department of Library and Information Science a) Master of Library and Information Science (b) Master of Science Records Management and Archives Administration (c) Master of Science Knowledge Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelors' Degree in related field with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any recognized institution. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
SCHOOL OF BUSINESS
Department of Business Administration Master of Business Administration (MBA) with areas of Specialization as: Human Resource Management, Entrepreneurship, Marketing, Finance, Strategic Management, Management Information Systems and Project Management, Procurement and Supply Chain Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university. Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university with proven ability in research, administration or management. A holder of a degree from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university plus relevant full professional qualification certificate.
SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM
Department of Hospitality Management Master of Science in Hospitality Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) and above in Hospitality and Tourism Management and related fields

Those with Second Class (Lower Division) in Hospitality and Tourism Management and related area with at least two years relevant work experience.
Department of Tourism Management Master of Science in Tourism Management Minimum Entry Requirements A holder of Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management (Second Class Honours Upper Division and above) and/ or related field. A holder of Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management (Second Class Lower Division) and related field with at least 2 years relevant work experience.
SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE AND ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT
Department of Agricultural Resource Management Master of Science in Integrated Soil Fertility Management (ISFM) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree in Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dry land Agriculture & Enterprise Development, Agricultural Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension, Plant and Microbial Sciences, Geography or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Resource Management Master of Science in Dryland Agriculture Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dryland Agriculture, Animal Production and Health Management, Agricultural Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension, Agricultural Economics or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Resource Management Master of Science in Land and Water Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dryland Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Range Management, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Education and Extension or any other equivalent qualification from other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Plant Breeding Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology M.Sc. Crop Protection in a) Entomology Option b) Pathology Option Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science degree with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate.
Department of Agricultural Science and Technology Master of Science in Seed Technology and Trade Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science Degree with at least First Class or Second Class Honours (Upper Division) in Agriculture or other related areas from Kenyatta University and other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate. Holders of Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have grade 'C' and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization or a postgraduate diploma.

Department of Animal Sciences Master of Science in Animal Nutrition and Management Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Science with at least Second Class Honours (Lower Division) degree in Animal Production and Health Management, Veterinary Medicine, Agriculture, Agricultural Resource Management, Dry land Agriculture, Range Management or any other equivalent qualification from Kenyatta University or other institutions recognized by Kenyatta University Senate. Holders of B.Sc degree with lower second class honours in the agricultural related areas must have at least two years relevant experience.
SCHOOL OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
Department of Geography Master of Science in Geomorphology Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent in Engineering, Hydrology, and related disciplines, Natural Sciences or Social and Human Sciences from a recognized university. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Geography Master of Arts in Urban and Regional Planning Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor of Arts, Science or Bachelor of Education Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from a recognized university and has studied Geography either as a major or regular subject to a degree level. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Public Policy and Administration: Masters of Arts in Public Policy and Administration (MPPA) Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree of at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) from a recognized university in any area of specialization. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) may be considered on condition that they have Grade "C" and above in units relevant to their areas of specialization.
Department of Kiswahili Master of Arts in Kiswahili Minimum Entry Requirements Bachelor's Degree with at least Second Class Honours (Upper Division) or equivalent from Kenyatta University or any recognized university with an average grade of 'B' in Kiswahili units. Those with Second Class (Lower Division) and at least two years relevant work experience may be considered.
SCHOOL OF APPLIED HUMAN SCIENCES
Department of Recreation and Sports Management Postgraduate Diploma in Sports Administration Minimum Entry Requirements Applicants for the Postgraduate Diploma in Sports Administration course shall have attained a minimum academic qualification of Bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a recognized University.
Department of Recreation and Sports Management Master of Science in Exercise and Sports Science Minimum Entry Requirements A holder of a First Class or Upper Second first Degree or its equivalent in a relevant discipline shall be considered. Graduates of Physical Education, Exercise and Sports Science or Recreation and Sports Management as well as those in related fields such as Medicine, Nursing, Nutrition and Special Education shall be considered. Holders of a relevant Postgraduate Diploma in Sports Administration and Management of Kenyatta University or any other

recognized University shall be eligible for admission to the programme while holders of a Postgraduate Diploma in related disciplines may also be considered.

The programmes are designed to allow students to study independently with minimal tutorial support. The programmes are co-ordinated in the following regional Centers; Nairobi, Nyeri, Mombasa, Nakuru, Embu, Kericho, Kisumu, Kakamega, Garissa and Marsabit.
