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RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR NYAYO HOSTELS

Whereas Kenyatta University has in place rules and regulations governing the use of all its hostels, the following are specific rules and regulations governing the use of Nyayo Hostels:

1.0 The Right to Accommodation

- 1.1 Kenyatta University reserves the right to allocate accommodation into the hostels and there is no guarantee of room allocation to any applicant.

2.0 Individual Occupant's Commitment

- 2.1 Every occupant must sign a mandatory commitment that he/she will adhere to all rules and regulations appertaining there off before occupancy.

3.0 Individual Commitment to Inventory

- 3.1 Every occupant shall sign a mandatory commitment appertaining to the inventory and the condition of the room.

4.0 Zero Tolerance to Cooking

- 4.1 Cooking is not allowed. There shall be zero tolerance to cooking in the hostels. As a result, no room occupant(s) should be found in possession of the following items:

4.1.1 Raw, uncooked and dry food items which are not edible in their current state.

4.1.2 Any form of cooking devices and general kitchenware.

4.1.3 Kenyatta university cutlery, utensils and crockery.

5.0 Alcohol and Drugs in Rooms

- 5.1 Possession and/or consumption of alcohol, drugs or any form of abusive substance in the rooms is strictly prohibited.

6.0 Room Surveillance

- 6.1 All rooms shall be under a 24/7 surveillance.

7.0 Routine Checks

- 7.1 There shall be regular mandatory routine checks for every room. The Hostel Management reserves the right to make spot checks in the rooms without having to give prior notice to the occupant(s). However, the room occupant(s) must be present.

8.0 Unauthorized Persons

- 8.1 The occupant of the room shall not allow unauthorized persons in his/her room. It is totally unacceptable to host overnight such unauthorized persons.

9.0 Room Charges

- 9.1 Room charges are subject to review from time to time.

10.0 Personal Volition

- 10.1 The choice to reside within the Nyayo Hotels is a personal volition. Any student who feels that he/she cannot observe the above rules and regulations is hereby advised to relinquish the room if allocated.

11.0 Misuse or Destruction of Items and Facilities

- 11.1 Failure to comply with the rules and regulations, the occupant (s) shall be held directly and personally responsible for the item(s) and the condition of his/her room. In the event that item(s) or the condition of the room or both do not meet the initial specification(s) or condition, the occupant(s) will be held liable in the following ways:

11.1.1 Immediate expulsion from the room.

11.1.2 The occupant(s) will lose their accommodation status from Kenyatta University hostels hence forth.

11.1.3 The occupant(s) will be surcharged for repairs and replacement of items and the conditions at his or her cost. Such cost will include among others, procurement, purchase, and replacement of items or conditions at a minimum cost of 30%.

11.1.4 The occupant(s) will be subjected to further disciplinary action by the university student disciplinary committee. (DSC)

12.0 Revision of Rules and Regulations

- 12.1 The University reserves the right to revise the Rules and Regulations from time to time and will keep the occupants(s) informed of any changes.
