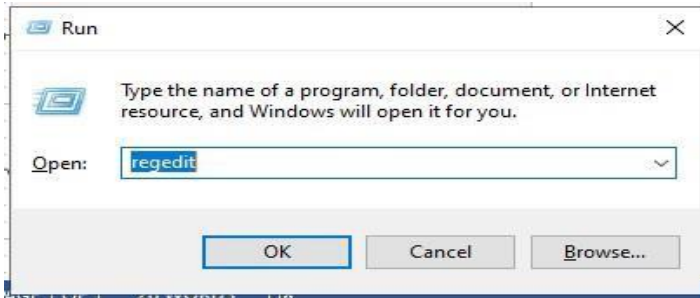


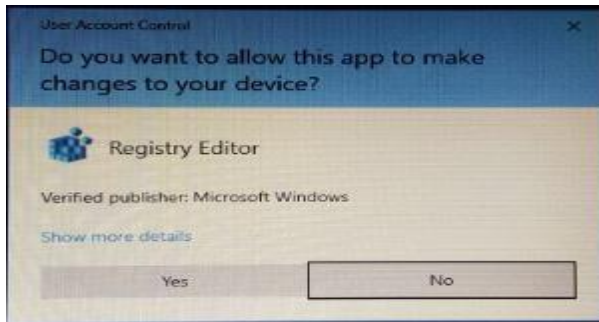
HOW TO CONNECT EDUROAM WIFI TO WINDOWS 11

STEPS

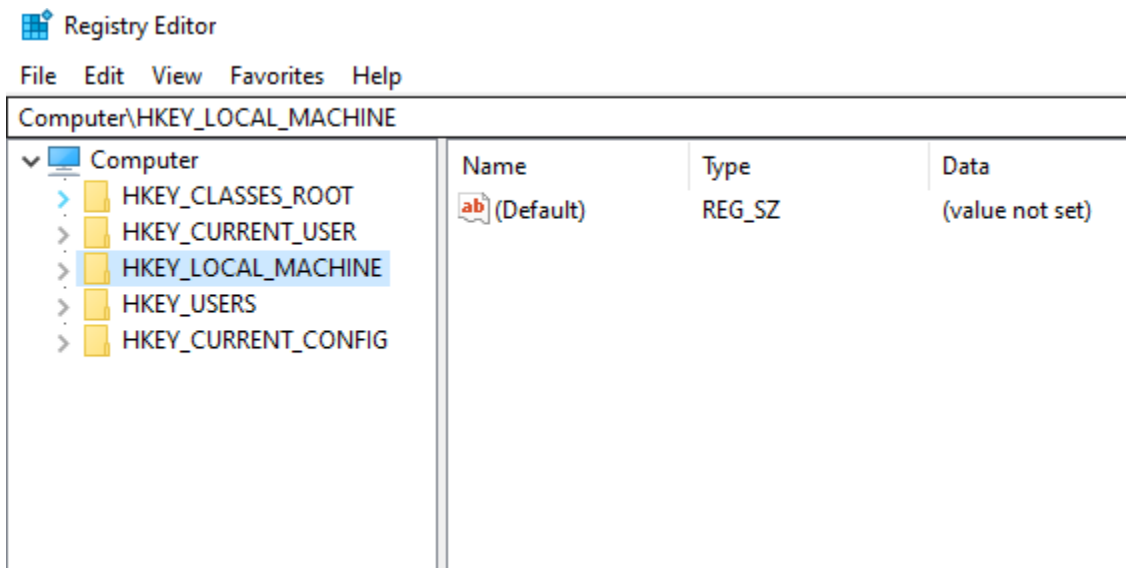
1. Click on start windows key, type Run and enter



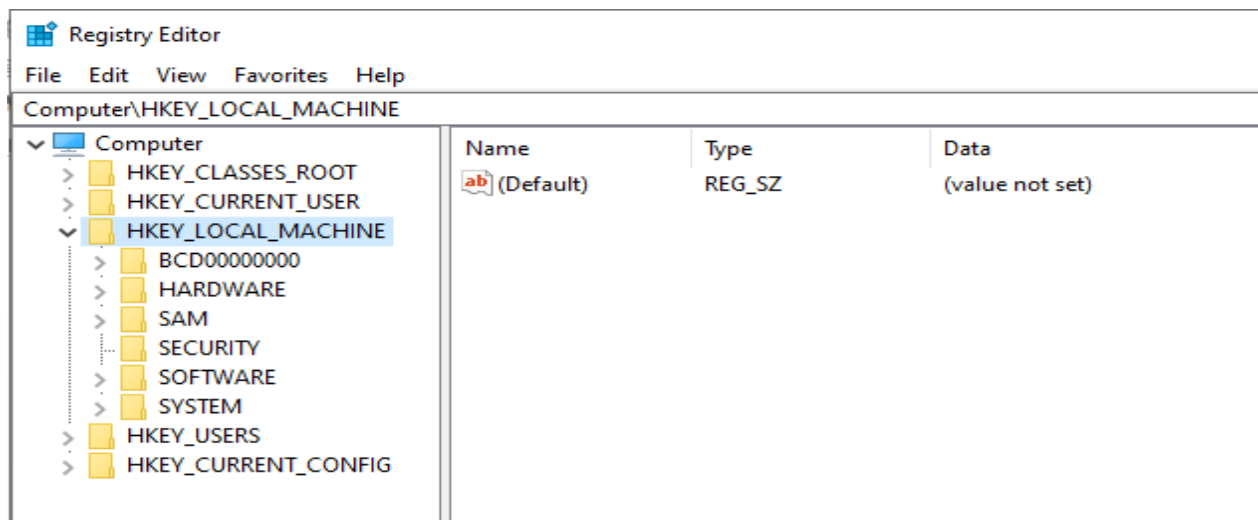
2. A pop window will appear type on the text box regedit

4. Pop Window will appear as shown



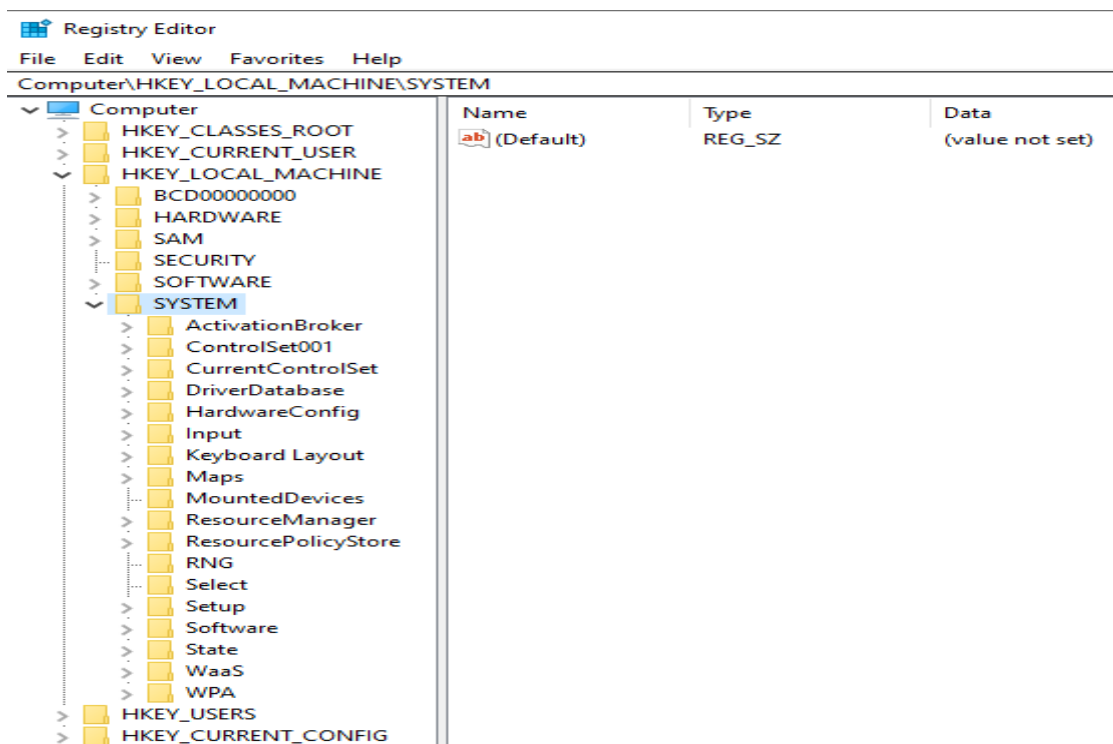
5. Click yes, a registry editor window will appear as shown below



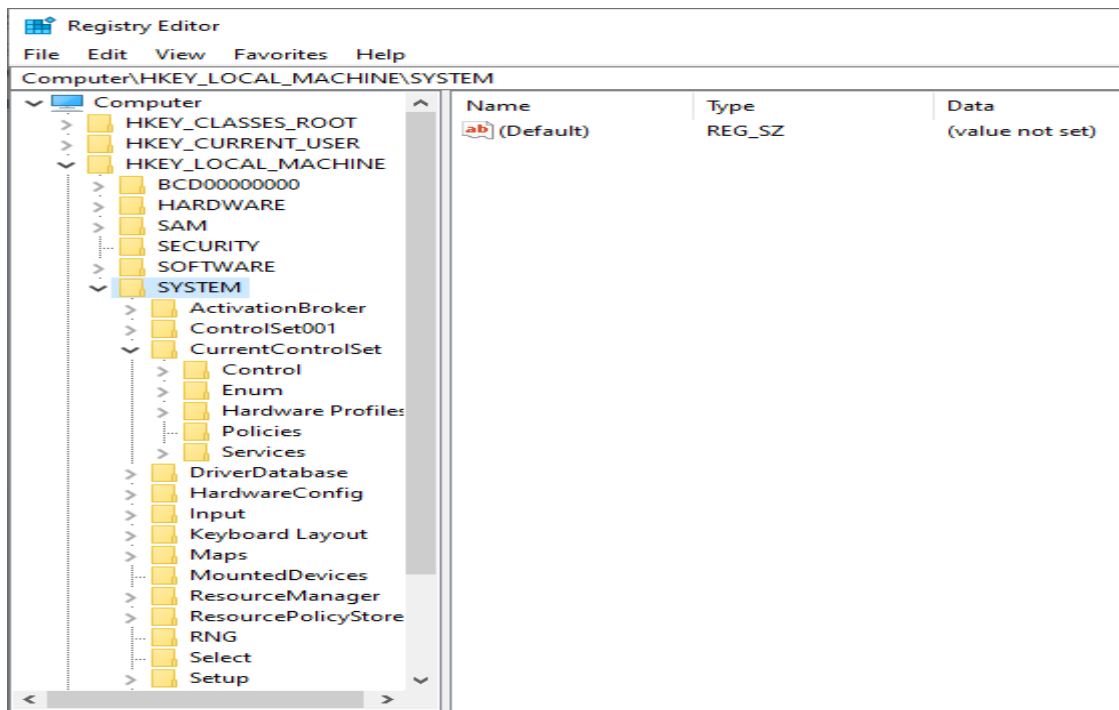
6. Expand HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE



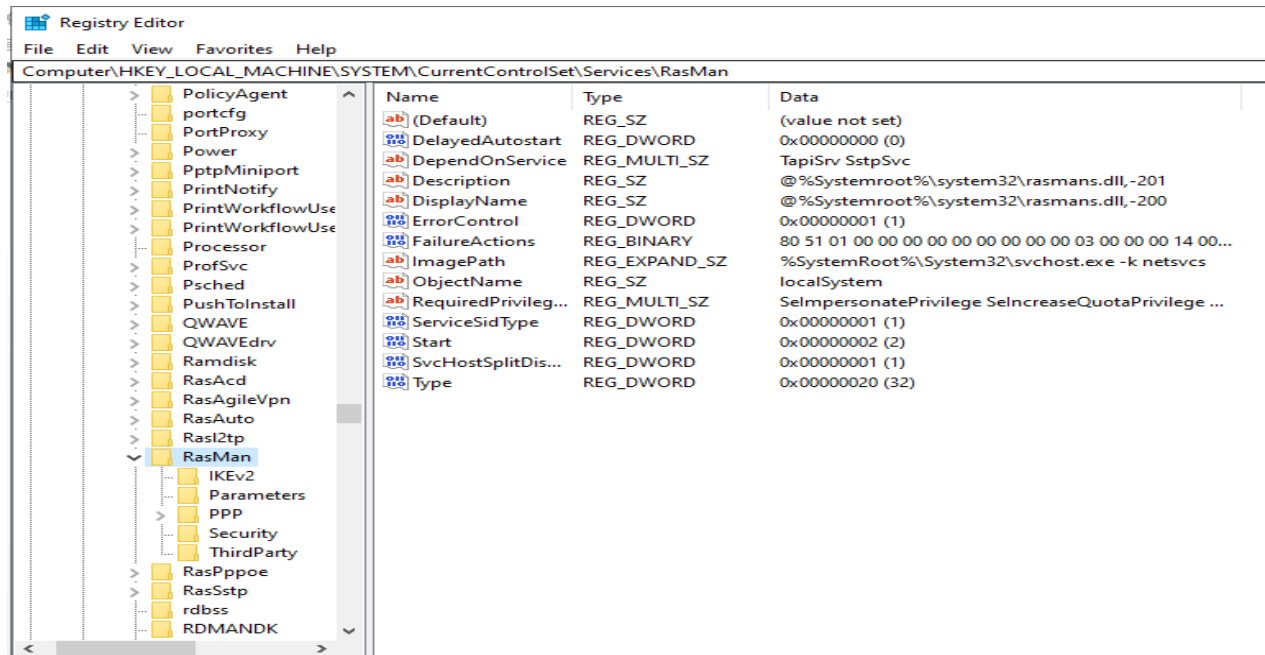
7. Expand on SYSTEM as shown BELOW



8. Expand on CurrentControlSet as shown BELOW

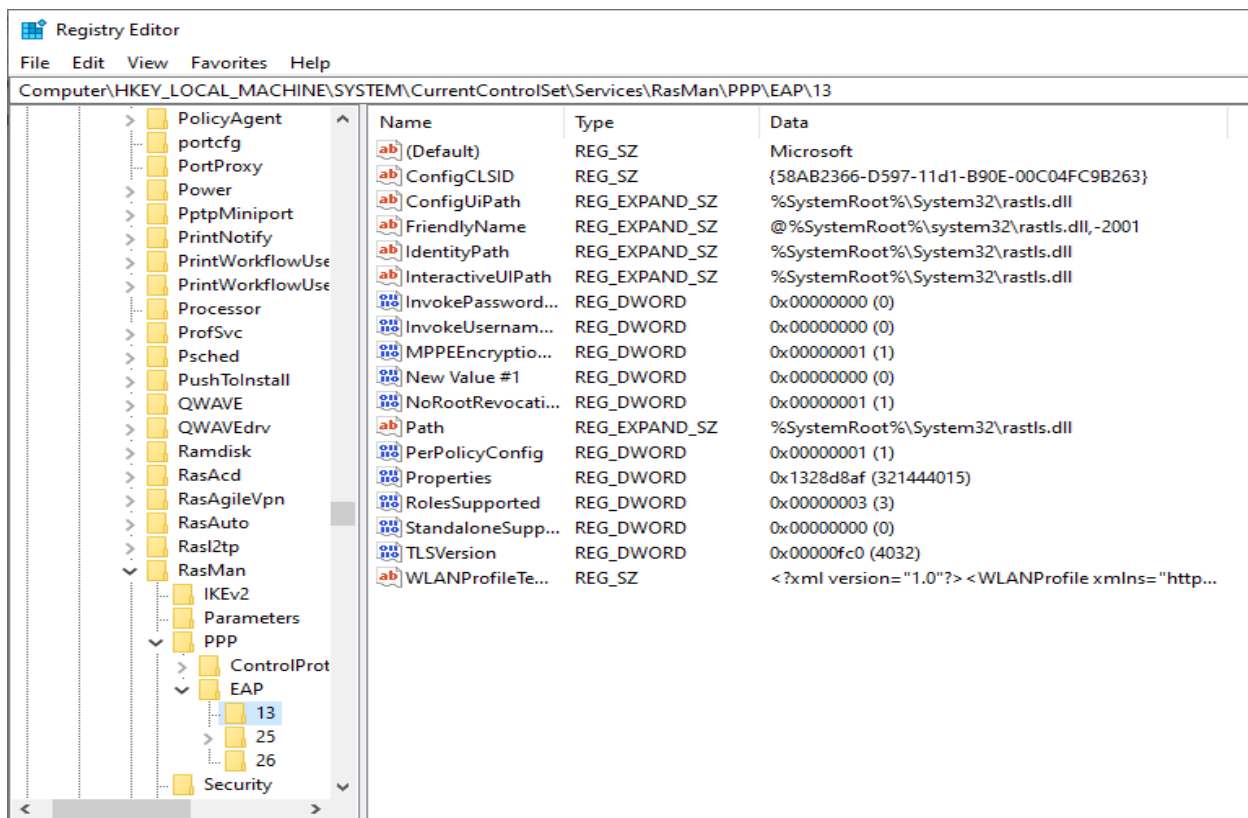


9. Expand on Services, scroll to RasMan expand it again as below



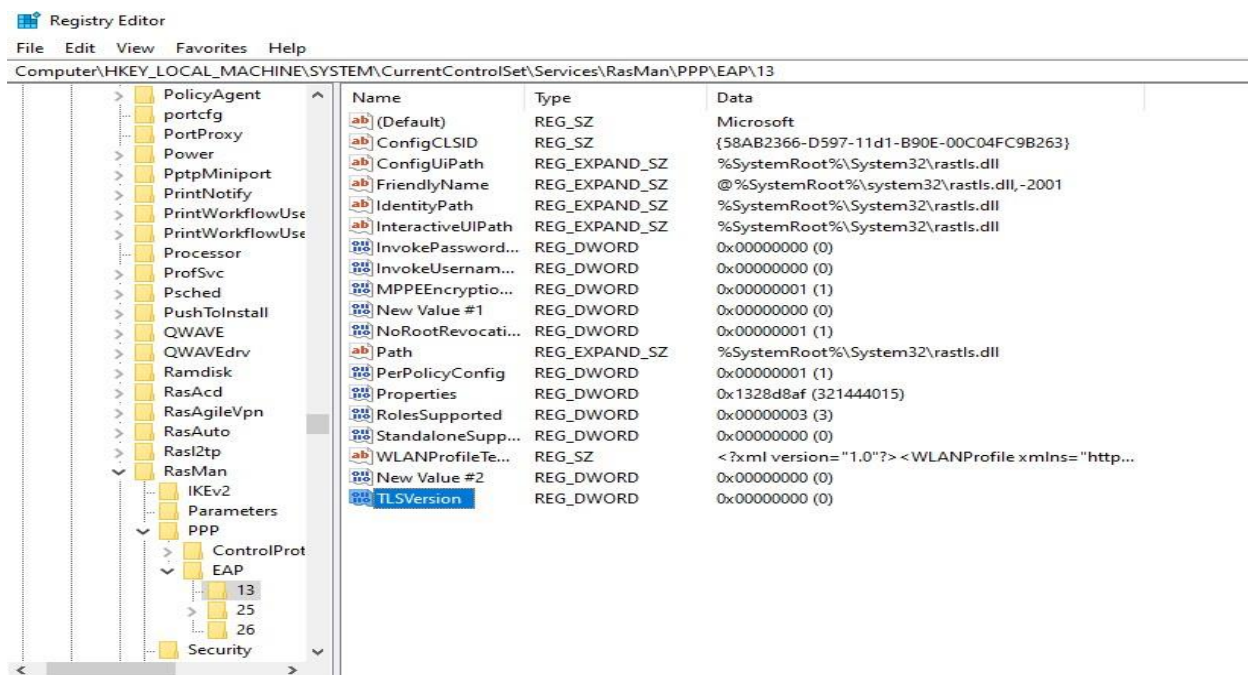
10. Double click on PPP and EAP to access Folder 13

11. Double click folder named 13

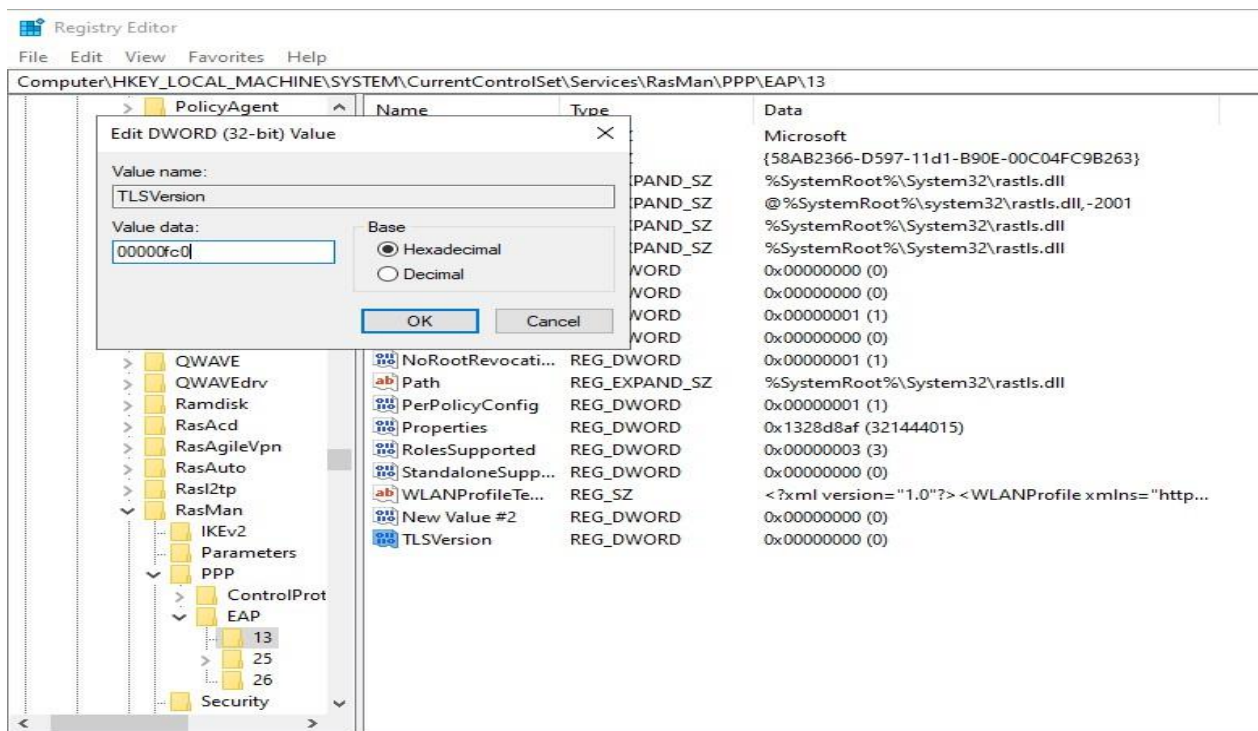

13. And name it TLSVersion as shown below



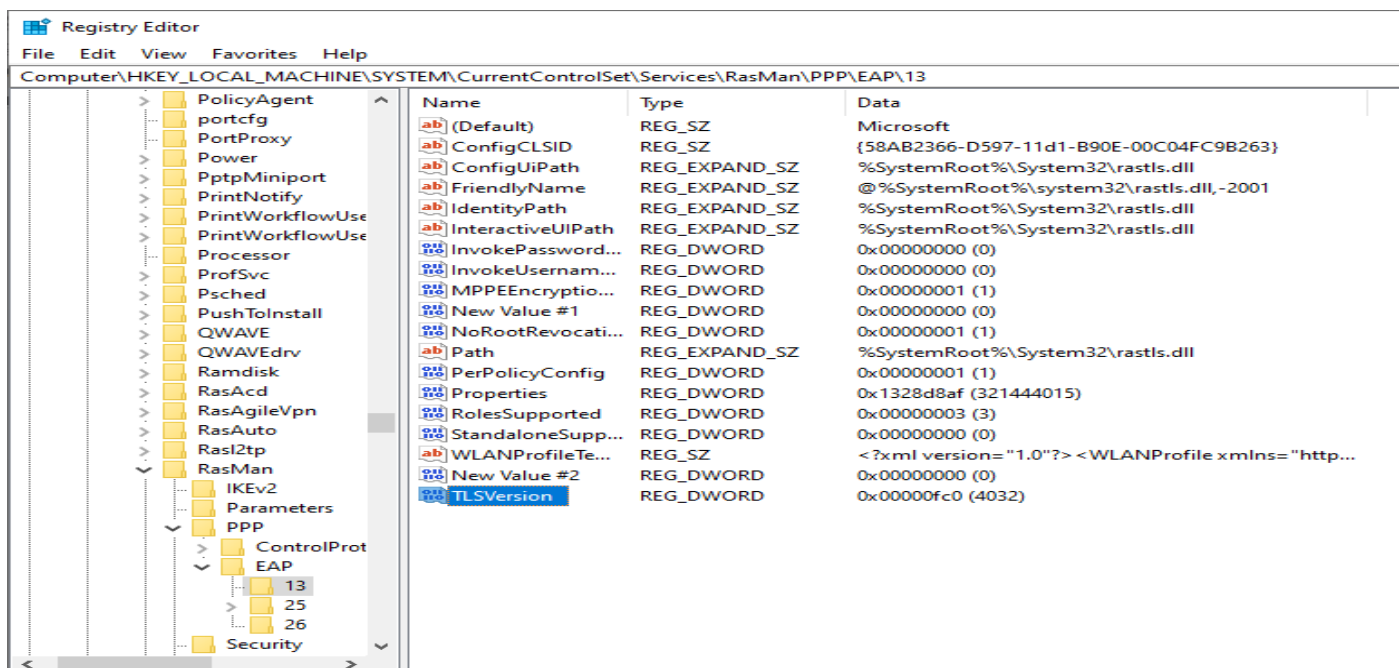
14 Double click on TLSVersion and type 00000fc0 under value data as shown below



15. Then click ok, the TLSVersion changes its values to

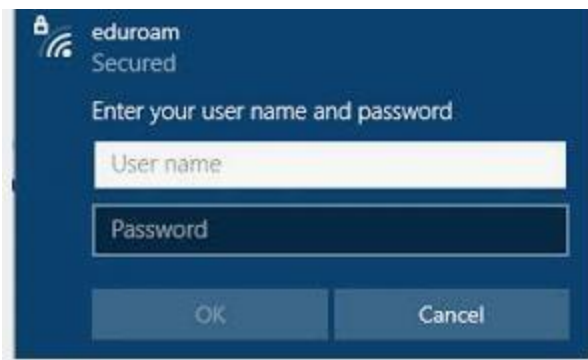
TLSVersion REG_DWORD 0x00000fc0 (4032)
